Main Purpose of the Role

Reporting directly to the Design Manager, you will be assisting the Design Team in producing CAD drawings, schematics and plans for both residential and commercial AV installations.

Main Responsibilities

1. Producing System Flow Schematics, AV Positional Layout Drawings, Rack Layout Drawings .etc.
2. Producing full installation AV Schematics and 'As-Builts'.
3. Assisting in the production of Cable and Components listings, including first fix cable schedules.
4. Producing 'mid-project' variation notes, drawings and records.
5. Specialist Drawings; As required for custom production work.
6. Tracking changes and developments in drawings & plans and reporting to the assigned Project Manager.
7. Co-ordinating the drawing development against Site Survey Results, and Sales and handover information including; Scope of Works, M&E Requirements, Method Statements and Risk Assessments.
8. Working to tender specifications and raising RFI's.
9. Raising variations within the design to the sales team, to ensure the system works as intended
10. Occasional site attendance will be required.
