Main Purpose of the Role

Reporting to the Operations Manager, the Project Manager will be responsible for on and off site management of AV/IT/Lighting Control/Window Treatment and CCTV installations in residential environments.

Following the department's project management processes, the Project Manager will be liaising directly with end users, Smartcomm Sales Consultants and the Smartcomm Design Team. The projects are expected to be delivered to the client's satisfaction, on time, on budget and to the high levels of quality expected. Applicants should be willing to work away from home for short periods of time. While the Smartcomm customer base largely covers the South East of England, it does extend across the UK and into Europe. They will be expected to present themselves in a professional manner while motivating their engineering team and driving the project to a successful conclusion.

Main Responsibilities
